What do you notice about this work of art?

The sphinx sculpture shows Hatshepsut, a female pharaoh of Egypt who came to power in 1478 or 1479 B.C. While acting as regent for young Thutmose III, she assumed and established her supreme authority. One way she did this was by commissioning statues of herself. To the Egyptians, a sphinx represented a king. Clearly, Hatshepsut marked a new beginning for herself and for Egypt as a female pharaoh.
